EVERGREEN TREES

<p>ARBORVITAE, AMERICAN <i>Thuja occidentalis</i> </p> <p>Also known as Northern White Cedar. Grows to a height of 40-50' with a spread of 10-15'. Moderately fast growing, long-lived tree. Prefers full sun to partial shade. Adaptable. Pyramidal shaped tree with flat, soft green scale like needles. Makes an excellent windbreak tree.</p>	<p>CEDAR, EASTERN RED <i>Juniperus virginiana</i> </p> <p>Grows to a height of 40-50' with a spread of 8-25'. Moderately fast growing. Prefers full sun. Adaptable to a range of soils and site conditions. Grows sharp green scale-like needles. This tree is very hardy; tolerant of deer, heat, drought and poor soils. Excellent for wildlife.</p>	<p>PINE, RED <i>Pinus resinosa</i> </p> <p>Also known as Norway Pine. Minnesota's State Tree. Grows to a height of 50-80' with a spread of 20-25'. Moderately fast growing, long-lived tree. Prefers well-drained, sandy soils and full sun. Has distinct reddish-brown bark that becomes thick scaly plates as it grows older.</p>	<p>PINE, WHITE <i>Pinus strobus</i> </p> <p>Grows to a height of 80-100' with a spread of 50-80'. Fast growing, long-lived, tallest conifer species in MN. Prefers full sun and rich, moist soils. Tolerates partial shade &amp; a wide range of soils. Buds are a favorite snack for deer and should be protected to discourage browsing.</p>
<p>SPRUCE, BLACK HILLS <i>Picea glauca var. densata</i></p> <p>Grows to a height of 40-50' with a spread of 20-35'. Naturally occurring variety of the native white spruce from the Black Hills region of SD. Slow growing, long lived conifer. Prefers full sun and moist to well drained soils. Tolerates dry sites.</p>	<p>SPRUCE, MEYER <i>Picea meyeri</i></p> <p>Grows to a height of 40-100' with a spread of 15-20'. Good alternative to replace Colorado Spruce. Slow growing, long-lived conifer. Prefers full sun and moist to well drained soils. Drought tolerant. Intolerant of standing water.</p>	<p>SPRUCE, NORWAY <i>Picea abies</i></p> <p>Grows to a height of 80 - 100+' with a spread of 40-50'. Native to Europe. Fast growing, long-lived tree. Prefers moist to well drained soil and full sun. Adaptable. Grows in a pyramidal shape with drooping branches.</p>	<p>TAMARACK <i>Larix laricina</i> </p> <p>Grows to a height of 50-75' tall with a spread of 15-30'. This deciduous conifer's needles turn yellow and drop every year in the fall. Fast growing. Tolerates wide range of soil conditions but grows most commonly on wet to moist organic soils in full sun.</p>



DECIDUOUS TREES

<p>BIRCH, PAPER <i>Betula papyrifera</i> </p> <p>Grows to a height of 50-70' with a spread of 25-70'. Moderately fast growing. Prefers moist to well drained soils and full sun; will tolerate wide range of soils. Hardy native that's intolerant of pollution.</p>	<p> CHERRY, BLACK <i>Prunus serotina</i> </p> <p>Grows to a height of 50-80' with a spread of 30-60'. Fast growing. Prefers partial shade to full sun and well drained soils. Adaptable, drought tolerant. Produces small, white, fragrant blossoms and bitter, small, purple-black cherries. Good wildlife food source.</p>	<p>CRABAPPLE, RED SPLENDOR <i>Malus "red splendor"</i></p> <p>Small tree. Grows to a height of 15-25' with a spread of 10-30'. Moderately fast growing. Prefers moist to well drained soils and full sun. Leaves are green or reddish, with white or pink flowers. Produces fruits up to 1" in diameter. Good wildlife food source.</p>	<p> HACKBERRY <i>Celtis occidentalis</i> </p> <p>Grows to a height of 40-60' with a spread of 40-60'. Fast growing. Prefers full sun and moist to well drained soil. Adaptable, drought, heat, strong wind, and salt tolerant. Produces small purple fruit, that stay on during most of the winter for wildlife.</p>	<p> LINDEN, AMERICAN <i>Tilia americana</i> </p> <p>Grows to a height of 60-100' with a spread of 30-50'. Fast growing, long-lived tree. Prefers partial shade to full sun and moist, well drained soils. Drought tolerant. Produces showy, light yellow flowers that are attractive to honeybees; its nectar makes excellent honey.</p>
<p>MAPLE, RED <i>Acer rubrum</i> </p> <p>Grows to a height of 40-70' with a spread of 30-50'. Moderately fast growing. Prefers moist to well drained soil and full to partial shade. Will tolerate occasional flooding and shade. Leaves can turn red, yellow or orange in fall.</p>	<p>MAPLE, SUGAR <i>Acer saccharum</i> </p> <p>Grows to a height of 60-80' with a spread of 30-60'. Slow growing, long-lived tree. Prefers moist well drained soils. Will grow in shade to full sun. Not tolerant of drought. Produces a dense, oval crown and displays yellow to orangish red leaves in the fall.</p>	<p>OAK, BUR <i>Quercus macrocarpa</i> </p> <p>Grows to a height of 70-80+' with a spread of 60-80'. Slow growing, long-lived tree. Prefers full sun and a variety of soils. Drought tolerant. Has simple lobed leaves and produces acorns. Good for wildlife.</p>	<p>OAK, RED <i>Quercus rubra</i> </p> <p>Grows to a height of 60-80+' with a spread of 40-65'. Fast growing, long-lived tree. Prefers moist to well-drained soils and partial shade to full sun. Tolerates drought, dry sites, and clay soil. Displays red or brown leaves in the fall that remain through winter. Good for wildlife.</p>	
<p> OAK, SWAMP WHITE <i>Quercus bicolor</i> </p> <p>Grows to a height of 50-60' with a spread of 50-60'. Moderately fast growing, long-lived tree. Prefers full sun and wet to well-drained soils. Drought tolerant. Displays red or brown leaves in the fall that remain through winter. Good for wildlife.</p>	<p>PLUM, AMERICAN <i>Prunus americana</i> </p> <p>Small tree. Grows to a height of 15-25' with a spread of 15-25'. Fast growing, short-lived tree. Prefers moist to well-drained soil and partial shade to full sun. Tolerates drought, dry sites, and clay soil. Fragrant white flowers are followed by edible fruits suitable for jellies. Thicket forming.</p>	<p>WALNUT, BLACK <i>Juglans nigra</i> </p> <p>Grows to a height of 50-60+' with a spread of 75-100'. Moderate to fast growing, long-lived tree. Prefers moist to well drained soils and partial shade to full sun. Produces the chemical juglone that can affect sensitive plants nearby. Produces a hard-shelled nut. Good for wildlife.</p>	<p>WILLOW, HYBRID <i>Salix matsudana/alba</i></p> <p>Grows to a height of 50-70'+ with a spread of 5-10'. Fast growing, short-lived tree. Prefers wet to well drained soils and partial shade to full sun. Single stemmed tree good for windbreaks. Avoid planting near other willows and in areas where uncontrolled spread is possible.</p>	

DECIDUOUS SHRUBS

<p>ARROWWOOD <i>Viburnum dentatum</i></p> <p>Grows to a height of 6-10' with a spread of 6-10'. Moderately fast growing, short-lived shrub. Prefers dry to wet soils and shade to full sun. Will tolerate clay soils and black walnuts. Produces cream colored flowers followed by small blue or purple fruits. Good food source for wildlife.</p>	<p>CRANBERRYBUSH <i>Viburnum trilobum</i> </p> <p>Grows to a height of 10-16' with a spread of 8-12'. Moderately fast growing, short-lived shrub. Prefers partial shade to full sun and moist to well drained soils. Will tolerate wet sites and occasional flooding. Produces white flowers &amp; red edible fruit. Creates a good snow fence. Good for wildlife.</p>	<p>DOGWOOD, REDOSIER <i>Cornus sericea</i> </p> <p>Grows to a height of 8-10' with a spread of 2-10'. Fast growing, short-lived shrub. Prefers partial shade to full sun and wet to well drained soils. Tolerates occasional drought. Grows bright red stems and produces clusters of white fruit. Good for wildlife.</p>
<p>HAZELNUT, AMERICAN <i>Corylus americana</i> </p> <p>Grows to a height of 3-10' with a spread of 8-15'. Moderately fast growing, short-lived shrub. Prefers partial shade to full sun and well-drained soils. Tolerates clay soils and black walnuts. Produces edible nuts eaten by birds and mammals. Variable fall color. Can reproduce by suckering.</p>	<p>LILAC, COMMON PURPLE <i>Syringa vulgaris</i></p> <p>Grows to a height of 10-15' with a spread of 6-12'. Moderately fast growing, long-lived shrub. Prefers full sun and well drained soil. Very adaptable. Large, round-headed shrub. Profuse bloomer, with purple flowers in the spring.</p>	<p>NANNYBERRY <i>Viburnum lentago</i> </p> <p>Grows to a height of 10-20' with a spread of 10-15'. Moderately fast growing, short-lived shrub. Prefers partial shade to full sun and moist to well drained soil. Will tolerate dry soils and shade. Glossy leaves with cream flowers followed by blue-black berries. Attractive for shiny foliage and red fall color.</p>

OTHER	TREE MAT	FERTILIZER PACKET	TREE TUBE
	A three foot square permeable woven plastic sheet that reduces weed competition and maintenance time, and protects soil moisture. Each tree mat comes with 5 staples.	A small packet filled with a pre-measured amount of fertilizer that is placed alongside the seedling at time of planting. The slow release of nutrients gives seedlings an extra boost.	A five foot plastic, vented tube which protects hardwood trees seedlings from animals, mower, and spray damage. Stakes are not provided; use any 5' stake with zip ties.
